Hazardous waste labels should be placed in a location on the container in a manner in which the label does not obstruct pertinent information on the original label (i.e. Chemical name, etc.). Additionally, chemical names must be written out on the hazardous waste labels. Please do not use chemical structures or formulas on the hazardous waste label or on this form.
